Annie Malone Children & Family Services

- **Economic Mobility:** *Equips children and families with tools to advance economically and socially via skills training, educational support, job readiness, emergency assistance, and wraparound services. DSS TANF funding.*
- **Parent Advocacy:** *Provides support services to foster families struggling with youth placed in their home, biological/relative/adoptive families seeking reunification with their children and families at risk of losing custody of their children. DSS Block Grant funding.*

Better Family Life

- **After School:** *Provides children with safe/educational environments during non-school hours – allowing parents to work and pursue educational opportunities. Site served: BFL campus. DSS TANF funding.*
- **Neighborhood Healing Network:** *Offers support services for crime victims. DSS VOCA funding.*

- **ABC Today:** *Partners with schools using ABC data (attendance, behavior, course performance in reading and math) to support students - addressing issues and bringing services to the child and family. DSS TANF funding.*
- **ABC Today Fatherhood Prevention:** *Connects boys with mentors, helping them understand and develop healthy relationships, promoting the delay of sexual activity, and helping them succeed in school. DSS TANF funding.*

Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater St. Louis

- **After School:** *Provides children with safe/educational environments during non-school hours – allowing parents to work and pursue educational opportunities. Sites served: Adams Park Club, Herbert Hoover Club, Larimore Elementary. DSS TANF funding.*

Bridging Families to Communities & Beyond

- **Youth Futures Career:** *Supports young adults that have or will transition from foster care by providing access to life coaches, education, job/skills training, housing, emergency services, employment, health care and community services. DSS TANF funding.*

- **Community Mentoring:** Provides educational, career exploration and mentoring services for justice-involved youth. DSS TANF funding.
- **Fatherhood Employment:** Provides workforce development activities focusing on skills training and job placement with a special emphasis on parenting skills. DSS TANF funding.
- **Neighborhood Healing Network:** Offers support services for crime victims. DSS VOCA funding.

Foster & Adoptive Care Coalition

- **Family Resource Center & Recruitment:** Provides foster, kinship, guardianship, and adoptive families with training, support groups, social activities, emergency funds/resources, in-home therapy and respite care. Focus on recruiting, training, and assessing individuals to become foster/adoptive parents. DSS Gen. Rev. funding.

Gateway Alliance Against Human Trafficking

- **Breaking the Chains of Human Trafficking:** Increases awareness and understanding of human trafficking in the state of Missouri. Provides training on recognizing potential indicators of being at risk for human trafficking and prevent the victimization of vulnerable individuals. DSS funding.
